abroad should hold positions of full professor or equivalent at a recognized scientific research institute or university.

- Possess extensive experience in research management and strong organizational and coordination capabilities.
- Expected to commit to full-time work and should be no more than 50 years old.

Deputy Director (2-3):

- Hold responsibility for assisting the director in management of the national Lab.
- Preference will be given to recognized experts in abovementioned areas. Applicants from abroad should hold positions of assistant professor, associate professor or equivalent at a recognized scientific research institute or university.
- Expected to commit to full-time work and should be no more than 45 years old.
